## **CATEGORIES**

This is a digital only nature competition with no prints. There are **seven** categories:

- 1. Landscape/Seascape
- 2. Botany
- 3. Birds
- 4. Mammals
- 5. Invertebrates
- 6. Other Nature
- 7. Urban Wildlife
- Image titles should be limited to no more than 45 characters of the English alphabet, or numbers, with no special characters.
- Polyptychs (diptychs, triptychs, etc.) are not permitted in this competition.

There is an entry limit of 10 images per club. Images may be entered in any category but to be eligible for the Club Diversity Awards clubs should enter at least one entry in each of the **seven** categories.

Nature and landscape/seascapes are defined for this competition as per the definition provided by the Australian Photographic Society Inc. (APS) with the exception of Urban Wildlife.

Only one image will be selected per MCC member.
